#### Texas Readiness Levels Never Improve Beyond Kindergarten Readiness






Note: Kindergarten readiness comes from the children enrolled in public PreK, for children not enrolled in public PreK, only 49% are considered "ready." Kindergarten Readiness is defined as students meeting or exceeding the cut-off score for a particular assessment on the Commissioner's List of Approved Assessments. Readiness is based on the literacy assessment only and does not provide comprehensive information on student readiness across all developmental domains.

## What does the Federal Reserve of Dallas say about childcare and economic development?

- Texas loses \$9.4 billion annually due to childcare-related workforce disruptions, including \$1.8 billion in lost tax revenue (U.S. Chamber Foundation, supported by Dallas Fed)
- Over 50% of families in El Paso lost childcare benefits under new workeligibility rules—impacting job stability and increasing turnover in low-wage sectors (Dallas Fed Beige Book, Jan 2025)
- Childcare and public transit are the top two barriers to employment across South and West Texas, according to workforce boards and employers (Dallas Fed Beige Book, June 2025)
